Company Barco Industries, LLC (referred to as “Barco” or “we/us”).

Payment Unless you have an approved credit account with available limit, payment is due in full before we mobilize. With approved credit, invoices are due 30 days from invoice date. Past-due amounts accrue interest at the maximum legal rate (not to exceed 18% per year). If we have to turn an invoice over for collection, you agree to pay reasonable attorney fees (minimum 20% of the unpaid balance) plus all costs.

Pricing & Changes - Quoted prices are valid for 30 days unless otherwise stated. We reserve the right to adjust prices or terms with notice. Short-notice call-outs (less than 24 hours notice) incur a +10% surcharge on the applicable day rate(s).

Taxes & Fees - Quoted prices exclude all taxes, duties, permits, or similar charges. These will be added to your invoice or billed separately if they apply.

Texas Tax Policy (Well Servicing Tax & Sales Tax) - Barco Industries LLC complies with all applicable Texas tax laws, including the Texas Well Servicing Tax (2.42%) and Texas Sales and Use Tax, as administered by the Texas Comptroller. **Well Servicing Tax (2.42%)**: Well-related services such as fracturing, acidizing, cementing, and other well servicing operations are subject to the 2.42% Texas Well Servicing Tax. Services subject to that tax are exempt from Texas Sales and Use Tax. This tax will be added to final invoices and may not appear on field tickets. **Sales and Use Tax**: If a service does not fall under the Texas Well Servicing Tax but is taxable under Texas law, the applicable Texas Sales and Use Tax (typically 6.25% + local rates) will be applied. Sales tax will also be charged on the sale of tangible personal property (e.g., tools, equipment, replacement parts, or materials) unless the customer provides a valid Texas Sales Tax Exemption Certificate. **Customer Responsibilities**: Customers who believe they are exempt from either tax must provide valid exemption documentation at or before the time of service. Third-Party Suppliers - If we have to buy from others to perform the work, we pass through their cost plus a 15% handling fee (or as shown on the quote).

Warranty - We warrant our services will be performed in a professional, workmanlike manner and that our services will be free of defects for one (1) year from delivery as seen on surface. We provide no other warranties, express or implied, including any warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. In no event will we be liable for subsurface, indirect, consequential, punitive, or special damages.

Limitation of Liability - Our total liability under any proposal or resulting work will not exceed the amount you actually paid us for the specific service or product giving rise to the claim.

Indemnity (Mutual) - Each party will defend and indemnify the other from claims arising from its own gross negligence or willful misconduct. Except for the foregoing, each party is responsible for its own people and property.

Force Majeure - Neither party is liable for delays or non-performance caused by events beyond its reasonable control (weather, strikes, acts of God, etc.).

Governing Law Texas law applies (excluding conflict-of-law rules). Venue for any dispute is Colorado County, Texas.

Entire Agreement / Master Services Agreement If a fully executed Master Services Agreement (MSA) exists between us, its terms control and supersede anything above. These simplified terms apply only when no MSA is in place or to the extent the MSA is silent.
